*Paper Planet*.

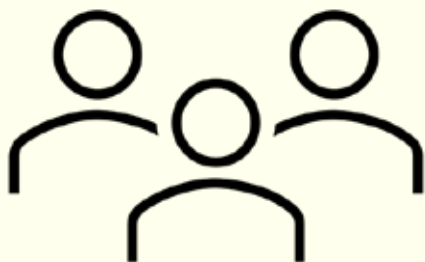
The Gallery is in the
