My family can leave whenever we are ready or want to have a break.

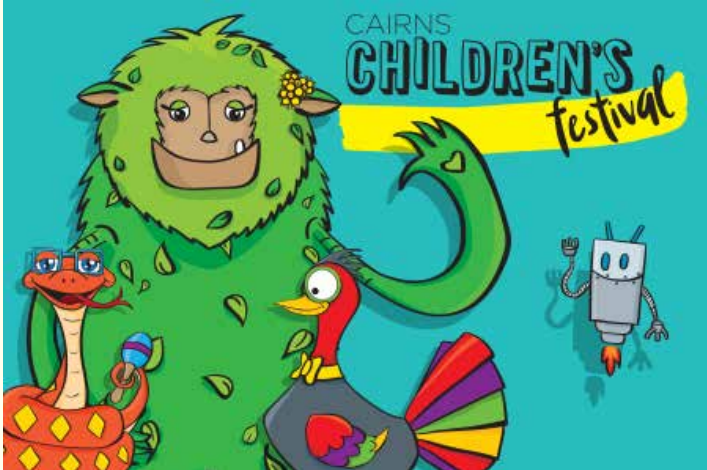


When the Bees need to leave, they will start moving away and the sounds will fade.
