There will be colourful signs and friendly people who will let me know that I am in the right place. I can say hello if I want to.

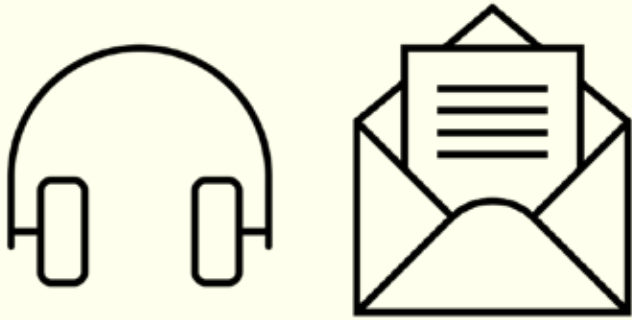


There is a break-out room if I need to feed my baby, change their nappy, or take a break.

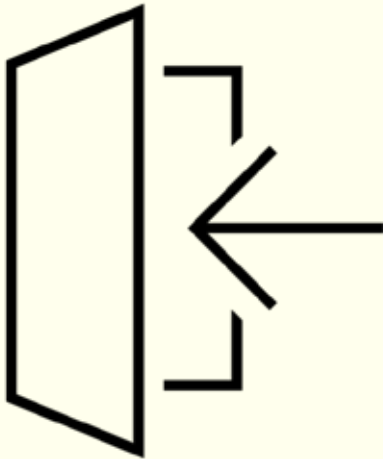


Other people will be arriving and they will also be part of *Pram People*, or they will be watching.

A friendly team member will guide me inside to the sign that matches my envelope.



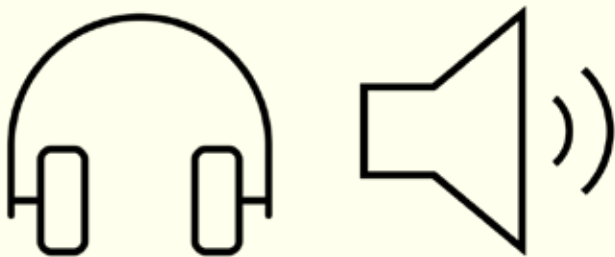
Other friendly team members will help me decorate my pram.

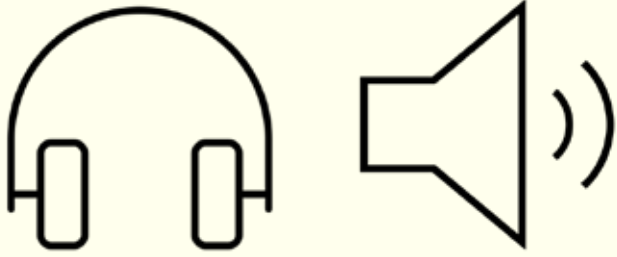

Performers will be moving around us and through the space.

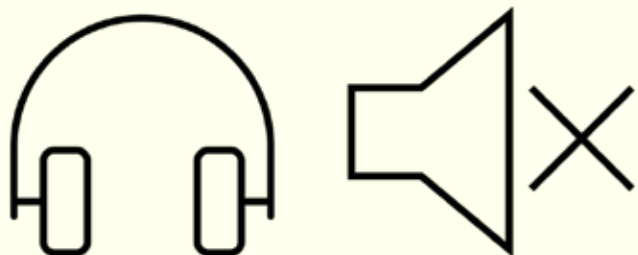


I might interact with the performers or other participants.



I can take a break at any point if me or my child needs one.

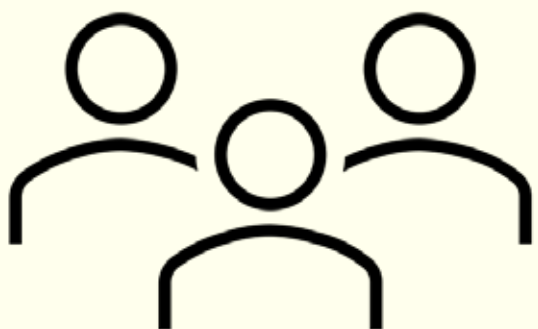
## *After Pram People*
