Ride or walk along the 'Ride the Sunset Coast' bike path.

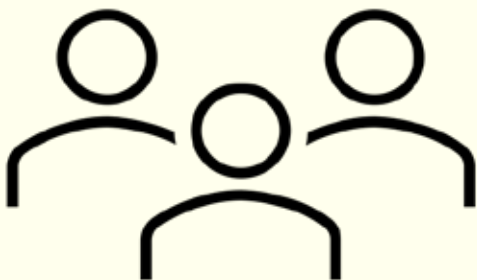
# Before *Pram People*



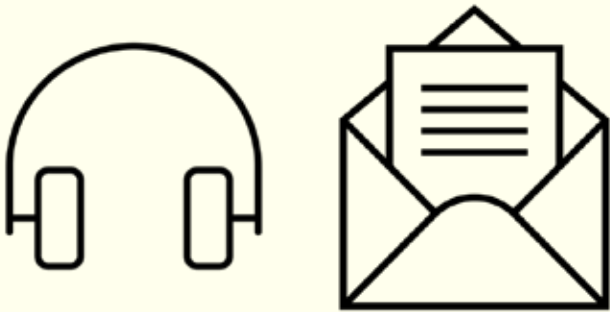
There will be colourful signs and friendly people who will let me know that I am in the right place. I can say hello if I want to.



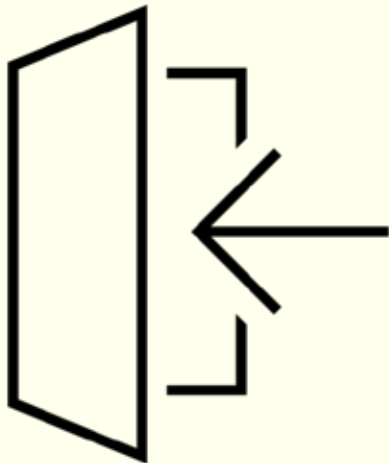
There is a breakout area and baby change facilities if I need to rest, to feed my baby or change their nappy.

A friendly team member will then guide me to the pram decorating station that matches my envelope colour.



Team members will help me decorate my pram in the marquee. My pram will be decorated with brightly coloured ribbons.



I will put my headphones on and I can go from the marquee to the waiting area.



While the other participants get their headphones and pram decorations, I can wait in or near the performance space.



When *Pram People* is about to start, I will hear instructions through my headphones. I will go to the performance space.

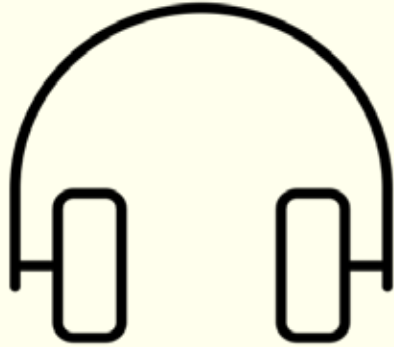
