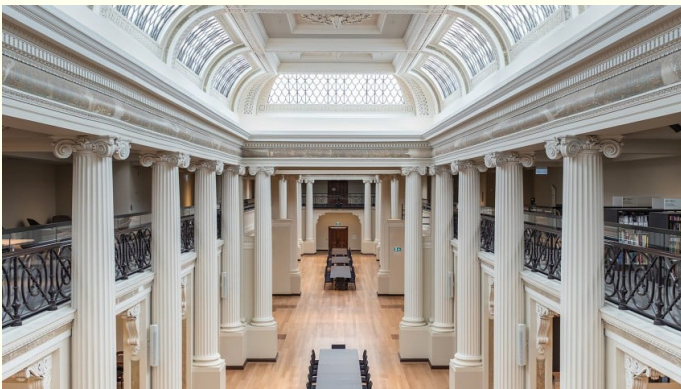

State Library Victoria is a large building with a lawn in front of it.



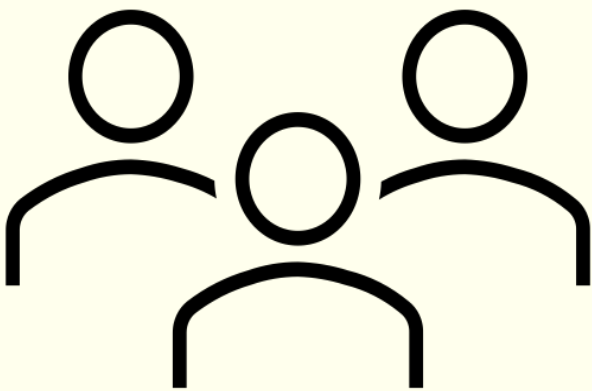
Inside it are many open spaces where people read.
