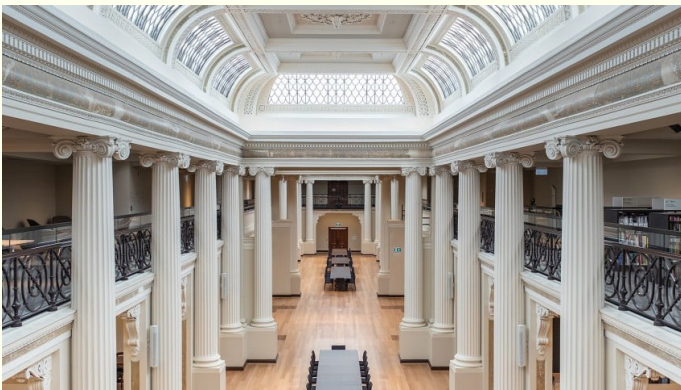

State Library Victoria is a large building with a lawn in front of it.



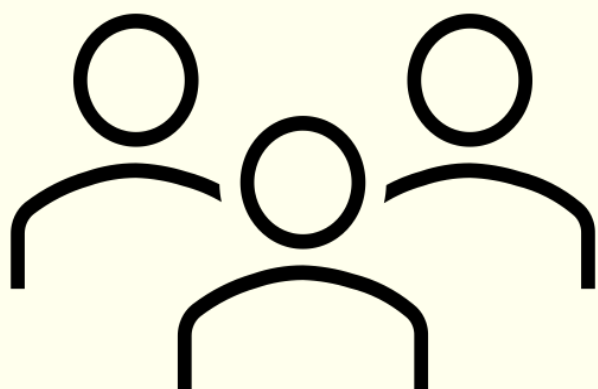
Inside it are many open spaces where people read.

Other children and families will be arriving to be part of the workshop or visit the Library.

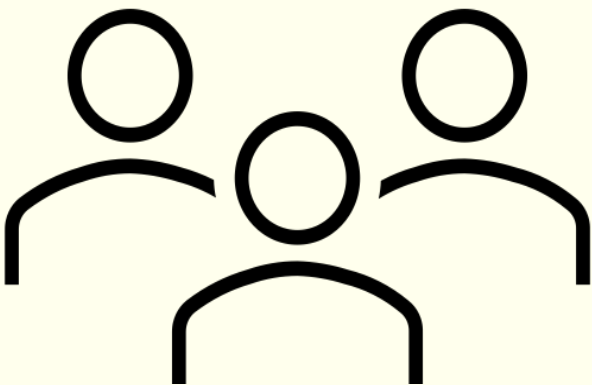
