ArtPlay is on the bank of the Yarra River.



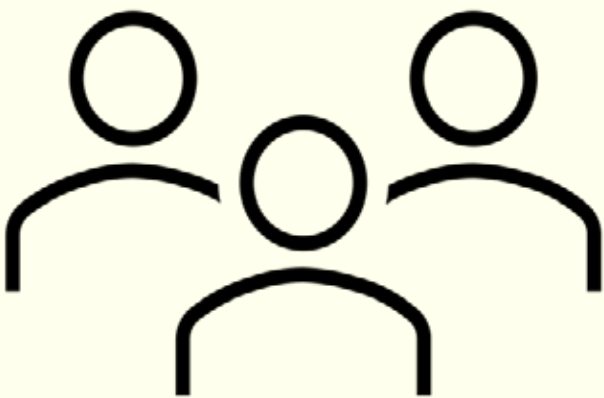
It is a red brick building...
