I will go to ArtPlay to be part of *Pass It On* workshops with performers from Polyglot Theatre.



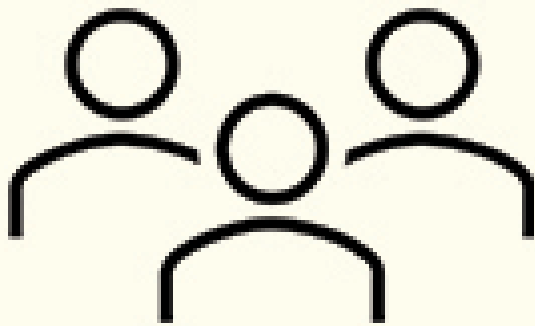
ArtPlay is a creative space for children and families behind Fed Square.
