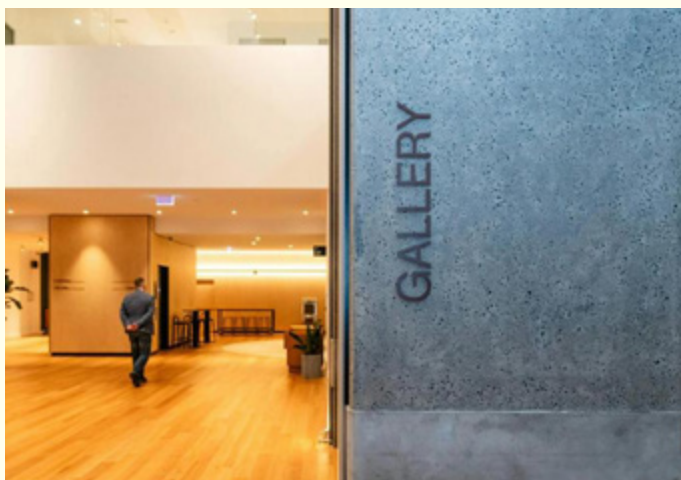
Before *Sound of Drawing*



I will go to Wyndham Cultural Centre to be part of an experience called *Sound of Drawing*.



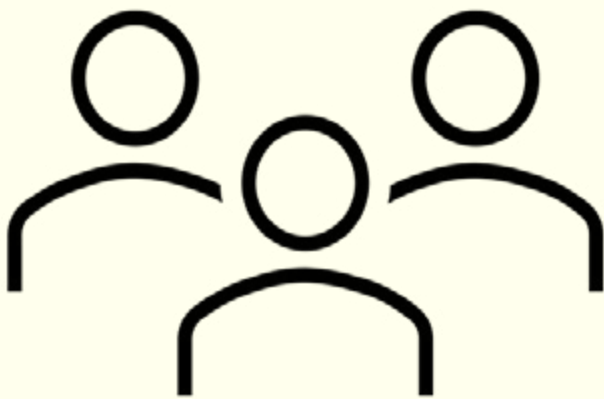
Wyndham Cultural Centre is a big building with tall glass windows. There is an art gallery and theatre inside.
